The University

Carleton University was founded in 1942 and is located in Ottawa, Ontario. Carleton has a student population of 23,000, providing undergraduate and graduate degrees in more than 65 areas of studies and supporting more than 90 research centres. The University is situated on a 62 heactare campus just south of the city centre, which is bordered by the Rideau River, the historic Rideau Canal (the longest skating rink in the world in winter when it freezes over) and pleasant residential neighbourhoods. Carleton is just minutes from the heart of Canada's capital city and majestic Parliament Buildings. An extensive tunnel system links all 31 buildings on campus, making Carleton one of the most accessible universities in the Country.

Location

Just minutes away from campus are a host of unique research and study resources including the National Archives, the National Research Council, the National Arts Centre, the National Gallery, the Museum of Civilisation and the Museum of Science and Technology. Ottawa is a cosmopolitan city, where people from various cultures live and work together. Theatres, outdoor cafes and dance clubs are part of the city's nightlife. Ottawa is situated between Toronto (a 5hr drive) and Montreal (2hr drive). The climate in Ottawa produces cold, snowy winters, with an average daily temperature of –9°C in January and a warm 20°C in July.

Travel


