The University

The Universidad de las Americas, Puebla (UDLAP) was founded in 1940 and is located in Cholula, just ten minutes away from Puebla. Puebla is situated on a high plateau in the centre of Mexico, 70 miles from Mexico City and 308 miles from Acapulco. The campus has beautiful colonial style buildings set in gardens. Athletic facilities include two gymnasiums, soccer and football fields, baseball fields, basketball and tennis courts and a swimming pool. Facilities on campus include a well-stocked library, computer rooms, bookstore, medical clinic, post office, travel agency, cafeterias and ATM's. UDLAP currently has 7,500 students including 230 international students.







Location

Cholula is one of the oldest cities in the country and a very important archaeological site, located 7,200 feet above sea level in a valley surrounded by mountains, with a temperature and sunny climate. Cholula has recently been designated by UNESCO as a treasure of Colonial Architecture and is among the five most important cities in Mexico. Various communities meet in Cholula for the annual celebration of the Virgin of Los Remedios and there are fantastic displays of arts, crafts, ethnic music and food during the festivities.

Travel

There is a regular bus service, leaving every 30 minutes, to Puebla from Mexico City International Airport.

Immigration


A student visa is required—student carnet (FM3). There is no consular fee if you are a British Citizen.
