

The University

The Australian National University was established in 1946 and is a world-class research and teaching institute. ANU is consistently recognised as Australia's most influential university and has a student population of 16,700 of which 60% are undergraduate students. ANU's inner city parkland campus is located in the heart of Canberra, a small, vibrant city nestled amongst some of the country's most beautiful natural environments. ANU has international links with leading universities in the UK, US, Europe and Asia. As the only Australian member of the International Alliance of Research Universities (IARU), ANU students and staff have numerous opportunities for collaboration and exchange that contribute to the University's rich intellectual climate.

Location

ANU is Located in the capital of Australia, Canberra, in the south-eastern region of Australia. With a population of 367,000, Canberra is situated 170 miles south-west of Sydney and 410 miles north-east of Melbourne. The campus is located in the city centre and covers 145 hectares with more than 200 buildings. There is plenty to see and do in Canberra and the surrounding region with wineries, historic townships, fishing, trekking, horse riding, and much more. Surrounded by verdant bushland and only a 2-3 hour drive from both Australia's ski-fields and the beautiful beaches of the South Coast, Canberra can cater to bushwalkers, skiers and surfers alike. Canberra enjoys more hours of sunshine than Sydney or the Gold Coast. Daytime temperatures range from $25 - 30+^{\circ}$ C in summer and $10-15^{\circ}$ C in winter.

Travel

The nearest airport is Canberra Airport is only 6 miles from ANU which serves only the domestic market. Students are advised to book a connecting flight from one of Australia's major international airports (most commonly Sydney). ANU offers a free "Meet and Greet" and airport shuttle service for newly arrived students (online registration required).

A short walk from ANU, the Jolimont Centre is Canberra's main interstate bus station. With regular, affordable bus services to Sydney, the South Coast, Wollongong and the Snowy Mountains, this is a popular means of interstate travel for students.
