## Who has rights?



If a couple has a religious-only ceremony where they are not legally married at the same time, they must have a civil ceremony to have the same legal rights as married or civil partnered couples. With a religious-only ceremony, each individual has no automatic rights to share the other's assets on death or separation. To seek a share an individual may need to go to court.

Many people think that if a couple live together for several years they have the same legal rights as married or civil partnered couples. THIS IS NOT TRUE! These individuals have no automatic rights to a share of the other's assets on death or separation. To seek a share an individual may need to go to court.
