

MA Cultures and Environments of Health 2024/25 Scholarship

The University of Exeter, in partnership with the Wellcome Trust, are delighted to offer two scholarships each worth £3500, to full time students enrolling on our MA Cultures and Environments of Health programme in 2024/25.

This opportunity is open to both home and international students.

Scholarship recipients will be selected on:

- Academic merit or relevant personal experience, based on the information supplied in your application.
- The ability to demonstrate the following as part of the application process: academic and professional ambition; and a genuine need for the scholarship to support these ambitions.

If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly.

This award is for one year only and is not recurrent for subsequent years of study. To apply, you must complete and submit an online application form, via the Funding database entry, including your responses to the following questions:

- What is your interest in the MA Cultures and Environments of Health programme what are you hoping to learn?
- What are your future ambitions and how will your studies help you to achieve them?
- What would being awarded a bursary mean to you – what difference would it make?
- How have your professional and/or life experiences contributed to your decision to apply to this course?

The deadline for applications is: 15 July 2024 Applications will be checked initially to ensure that the eligibility criteria have been met.

Applications will then be considered by a nominated panel. Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by email by 2 August 2024.

If you are offered the award then the offer email will explain the next steps. You cannot normally receive more than one scholarship from the University of Exeter; if you are eligible for multiple scholarships you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value.

If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body with whom the University has a shared financing agreement this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement. If you expect to receive funding from a charity this may also make you ineligible to receive this scholarship.

It is your responsibility to inform us if you are in receipt of any external funding prior to enrolment; please send a soft copy of the award letter to admissions_pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk Please note that candidates whose tuition fees may be wholly or partly paid by their employer can be considered for this award.

If you defer your 2024/25 offer or change fee status then your bursary offer will be invalidated. In the event that you withdraw or interrupt your studies post enrolment then the University Finance regulations at that date will apply as regards any repayment or other requirements:
