

## University of Exeter Thailand Undergraduate Scholarship 2024/25

The University of Exeter is offering scholarships to international students from Thailand enrolling on an eligible Undergraduate programme in September 2024.

These scholarships have been created to provide the opportunity for more students from this country to become part of our community of learners and develop their academic skills for the future.

These awards are available to applicants who:

- are a citizen/passport holder of Thailand and therefore classed as an International student for fees purposes; and
- hold an offer to study an eligible campus-based Undergraduate programme at the University of Exeter, as set out below.

Award Amount	Entry point
£5,000	Entry to the first year of an eligible Undergraduate programme in September 2024.
£3,500	Direct entry to the second year of an eligible Undergraduate programme in September 2024.

Students progressing from INTO University of Exeter International Foundation or INTO University of Exeter International Year One are not eligible. Students joining the University through an institutional progression or articulation agreement where a tuition fee discount is applied are not eligible.

Ineligible Undergraduate programmes are: all Flexible Combined Honours; BMBS Medicine; Degree Apprenticeships; Dual LLB/Juris Doctor (JD) with the Chinese University of Hong Kong; LLB Law (for Brickfields Asia College only) LLB Engineering and Law (HKUST); Legal Practice Course; Graduate Law LLB.

This award will be automatically allocated to eligible applicants; a separate application is not required<sup>i</sup>. To accept an award applicants should make the University of Exeter their Firm choice by their UCAS deadline. Awards cannot be allocated to applicants who have already made the University of Exeter their Insurance choice.

Awards will be received by those applicants who are placed at the University of Exeter and enrol on that eligible programme in 2024/25.

These awards are intended for self-funded students.

This scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees; it cannot be paid as cash or attributed to other charges such as accommodation fees. It will be automatically deducted from the tuition fees for your first-year of study, following enrolment. If you choose to pay your tuition fees in instalments, the award will be deducted from the total annual tuition fee and the remaining balance split accordingly<sup>ii</sup>.

This award is for one year only and is not recurrent for subsequent years of study.

You cannot receive more than one scholarship from the University of Exeter; if you are eligible for multiple scholarships, you will be awarded whichever scholarship has the higher value. If your tuition fees will be financed by an external body (such as an overseas government or a partner Institution) with whom the University has a shared financing agreement, then this award may be invalidated or superseded with a different fee arrangement.

If you expect to receive funding from a charity this may also make you ineligible to receive this scholarship.

If you defer your 2024/25 offer or change fee status, then your scholarship offer will be invalidated. <sup>ii</sup> Tuition fees deduction/s due are applied to your student account and show in your online statement within the first four weeks of study. Any awardees studying part time (under the relevant visa regulations) will receive the full scholarship deduction in their first year
