

Access to Internships (A2I)

- provides support and funding to help eligible students arrange a paid internship in the UK.
- students can apply for one employer subsidy and one 'Help Getting to Work' bursary, per year.
- 3 different types of funding:
 - a. University of Exeter Internship (with an Academic or Professional Service)
 - b. SME (less than 250 employees), Charity or Statutory Organisation
 - c. 'Help Getting to Work' Bursary





Opportunity to develop • intercultural skills

> Typically one week in duration
