- Newsletters

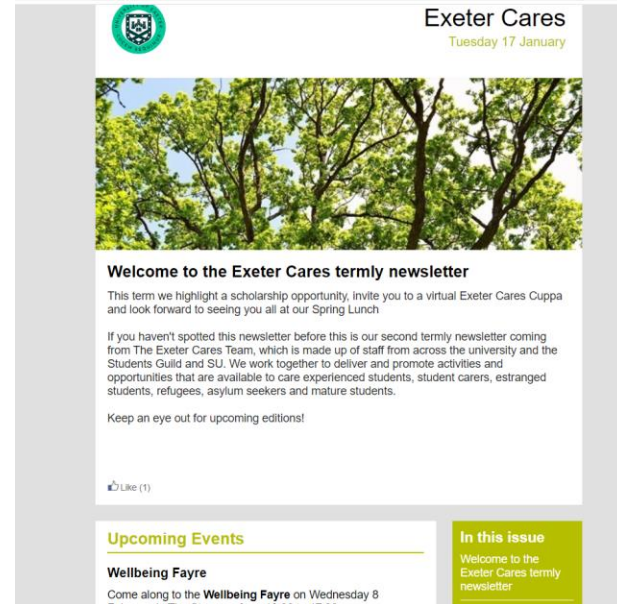
Termly Newsletters
