The PGT Admissions application process:

- -Applications open in mid-late September for the following academic year.
- -Application links are live on all available programmes running and with the full and part time variations.
- -Make sure you complete the mandatory sections and upload the required documentation at the point of application. This will speed up the turnaround time on your application.
- -Once you have submitted your application our goal is to have a decision sent out to you within 20 working days.

What do you need to do provide?

- Academic documents:
- An up-to-date transcript listing all your modules and scores.
- If you have graduated please also provide your degree certificate.
- Ensure your agency is selected.





Personal statement



This should be around 500 words/1 side of A4

Include why you have chosen to the apply to the University of Exeter and the reasons for studying the Masters course that you have applied for.

What did you learn from your undergraduate course and what do you hope to the do in the future after achieving your Masters?



CV

-Clearly showing all previous relevant work experience. Including dates and descriptions





Evidence of English Language

- This is relevant for International students the English language requirements are listed as grade bands on the website for each individual courses
- The majority of tests that we receive to meet this condition are IELTS or TOEFL tests. But you can find on our website all English language tests that we accept.



Letter of recommendation

- Our MBA programme requires two references. All other Masters courses require one.
- This can either be a reference from an academic or if you have been out of education for a while we can accept a professional reference.
- We require these references to be in PDF format have official headers on them and be signed. We can also accept references emailed direct from your academic to the admissions team on to pg-ad@exeter.ac.uk from an official email address. Please ask your referee to include your 9 Digit Exeter reference number which will start 74.. it will make it far easier to locate your application.
- Please note that Admissions does not contact referees direct for their reference and it is the responsibility of the applicant to provide these.





Fast Track process

This is for final year UG Exeter students

Apply via the Fast Track link on website

Fast Track applicants do not need to provide a transcript as their scores automatically pull through on the applicant portal. No reference required either, or personal statement.

PGT Admissions turn around Fast Track applications within 5 working days.





The application processing structure:

- -Compare your academic achievements to our set equivalencies & criteria
- -If we need further information we will be in touch or if we need more guidance we can refer your application to the faculty.
- -Assess your English language qualifications to ensure the meet the standards.
- -Assess your fee status
- -Assess your academic progression
- -Ensure your letters of recommendation meet the requirements.
- -Allocate the correct deposit amount Home students £100. International Students £2,500.





The next steps:

- -Send out an official decision via email, which will include all essential information ie. Conditions of your offer, deposit payment deadline.
- -You can check via the applicant gateway regarding the status of your application.
- If you have any queries, we have multiple platforms that you can contact us on. IE. GECKO, email, phone or in person.
- -Make your deposit payment before the deadline & submit all the required documents ideally by 31st July.
- -Please ensure you upload all documentation as soon as possible.





What can applicants do via the applicant gateway?

Upload academic documents

Request deposit extensions

Defer your application for the following year (one deferral allowed)

You can "accept" your offer – although paying your deposit formally confirms this

Withdraw your application





The Undergraduate Admissions Process



Key dates for 2025 entry:

- -14 May 2024 Students can begin their applications
- -24 July 2024 Online Open Day
- -31 August 2024 No further changes for 2025 entry
- -3 September 2024 Applications can be submitted
- -5, 12 & 26 October 2024 In person Open Days
- -15 October 2024 Medicine Equal consideration date
- -29 January 2025 Equal consideration date for all other programmes

- All standard applications for UG programmes need to go via UCAS.
- All information and guidance can be found on our international student webpage.
- Applications for clearing will be available from the 3rd of July 2024.

- CAS documentation can and will only be released when the applicant has met all the conditions of their offer and has paid their deposit.
- Applicants may have to complete a PRE-CAS interview- this is specified in their offer letter, and will only occur when the applicant has paid their deposit.
