The modules (EDU2016, EDU2017, EDU3013 and EDU3014):

- Are available in 15 and 30 credit options (involving either one or two week placements respectively)
- Can be taken at level 5 or level 6 by 2nd, 3rd or 4th year undergraduates and by Masters students (subject to approval and timetabling)
- Are open to students from any discipline in the University
- Involve an online virtual placement and the possibility of an optional face-to-face placement.
