




Operation One Chance: Evaluation

Participant retention - Wow!

- 86% participant retention at 6 month follow-up
- Would normally expect c.10-50%
- · Proof of concept
- Effects of self-reporting driving behaviour over extended period
- · Opportunities for micro-dosing
