

Leadership Professional Development

Team Leader / Supervisor, Level 3

Supervisor, Team Leader, Project Officer, Shift Supervisor, Foreperson, and Shift Manager.

This qualification is for supervising or junior managers and has been designed to support the development of their knowledge and competence in managing individuals and teams and developing skills, including working with others, managing oneself, and coordinating the work of others. Achievement of the qualification confirms competence in an occupational role to the standards required.

Operations/Departmental Manager, Level 5

Operations Manager, Regional Manager, Divisional Manager, Department Manager and specialist managers.

This qualification is aimed at practising or aspiring managers and leaders who are typically accountable to a senior manager. The primary role of a practising or aspiring manager and leader is to lead and manage individuals and teams to deliver aims and objectives in line with organisational strategy.

Cohorts start in April and September.

Chartered Manager Degree, Level 6

Manager; Senior Manager; Head of Department; Operations Manager; or anyone with significant management responsibilities.

This qualification is designed for individuals wishing to develop professional management and leadership practice who will have the knowledge, skills and behaviours to drive business activities in a senior management and leadership role. It is also suitable for those who have been promoted to a managerial role and want to gain a formal management qualification.

Cohorts start in September with external application opening in March.

Senior Leader Master's Degree, Level 7

Section Leader, Executive, Director, Chief Operating Officer, CFO, CEO, Chief Information Officer, senior military officer, HE Registrar and Head of Department/Faculty

This qualification is designed for individuals wishing to develop strategic management and leadership practice who will have the knowledge, skills and behaviours to drive business activities in a senior management and leadership role.

Please note application to this course (with the MBA top up) will now be reviewed by a panel from the PS Directors Leadership Team (PS-DLT).

Cohort start dates are April and September, with the external application submission opening in November and June respectively.
