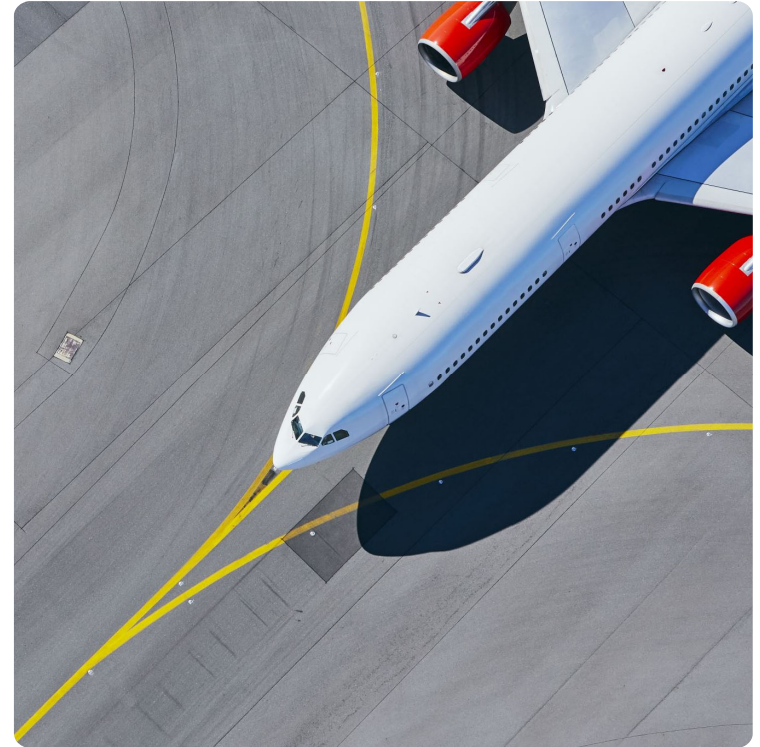


# Getting from Bristol Airport

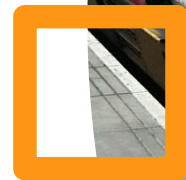
# There's several ways to continue your journey

 Rail: Catch the Bus from Bristol Airport then train to Exeter St David's

OR

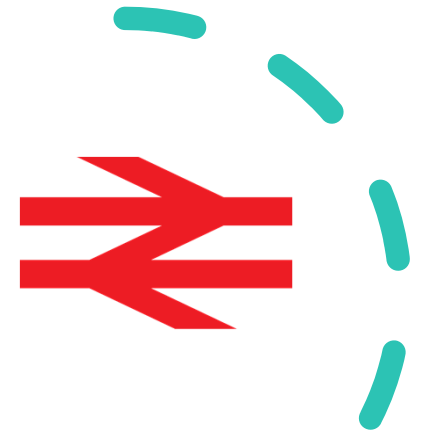
 Coach: Catch a coach from outside Bristol Airport

# Travelling By Train

When you arrive at Bristol Airport you will need to catch the A2 bus (also called the Airport Flyer Express) from outside the terminal to Bristol Temple Meads.

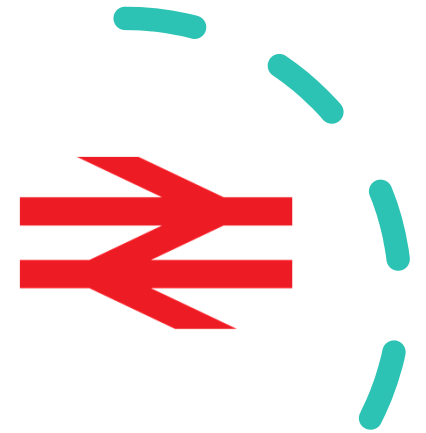


The Airport Flyer Express leaves every 20 minutes and is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. It takes around 30 minutes and drops you at the railway station.

Trains from Bristol Temple Mead to Exeter St David's run roughly every hour and the journey takes about 1 hour. There are no changes on the train.

It is advisable to pre-book your ticket due to price and availability. Here is the website for booking your train tickets online: <https://www.thetrainline.com/>.

# Travelling By Coach

You can either travel with Megabus or with South West Falcon to reach Exeter from Bristol

## Megabus:

- Coaches depart outside the terminal every couple of hours
- It takes roughly 1 hour 40 minutes to reach Exeter Honiton Road Park and Ride – no changes
- Tickets must be bought in advance and are roughly £10
- You can purchase tickets here: <https://uk.megabus.com/>

## South West Falcon:

- Coaches depart outside the terminal every couple of hours
- It takes roughly 2 hours 5 minutes to reach Exeter Sowton Park and Ride – no changes
- Tickets do not need to be pre-booked, they can be bought from the driver on the day. They are roughly £10
